Dear Students, Faculty, and Staff,

Our university has been through tremendous changes over the past couple of years. In experiencing these changes, we have been faced with more than a few challenges, overcoming each one.

We were recently informed that on February 22, 2010, our regional accrediting organization, the Higher Learning Commission (HLC), voted to remove the University from Probation and to issue a Show Cause Order. This means that in order to retain accreditation we must prepare a report by December 1, 2010 demonstrating the University has addressed certain ongoing HLC concerns. We continue to be accredited by the Higher Learning Commission.

The Report will be followed with a visit by an Evaluation Team in January, 2011 to validate the contents of the Report, and the University's status will be considered again by HLC at its February, 2011 meeting.

Over the next nine months as we prepare our report, we will continue to improve our processes and enhance the quality of our service.

Our Report will show that we can sustain the progress that we have made and continue to move our University forward. I am confident that we will successfully demonstrate the University's full compliance with all of the HLC criteria for accreditation.
